LANDMARKS PRESERVATION GUILD APPLICATION

The Landmarks Preservation Guild (LPG) is a committed group of volunteers who examine and maintain works of art in the Landmarks collection. They devote time and energy to preserve works of public art so they may be enjoyed by future generations.

Volunteers learn maintenance methods through training sessions led by a conservator. These include techniques to monitor and record changes in works of art, to wash and wax outdoor sculpture, and to clean works of art made of bronze, steel, painted metal, wood, and stone.

LPG volunteers contribute an average of two hours every other week to the program, with mandatory 4 hours for training in the fall semester, and are asked to commit for at least one academic year (two semesters).
